# 1. The Money Reality

Nobody budgets for this stuff — but they should.

Expense	Hawaii Cost	Notes
Gallon of milk	\$6–8	
Electricity (per kWh)	\$0.38–0.45	vs \$0.16 national avg
Monthly electric bill	\$250–\$450+	
Gas per gallon	\$4.50–\$5.50	
Family groceries/month	\$1,200–\$1,800+	
Oahu 2BR rent	\$2,800–\$3,600/mo	

## Bottom Line Income Target

### Single Adult

\$60–75K minimum

### Family of 4

\$120–150K+ to breathe

## 2. Which Island — This Decision Changes Everything

Island	Vibe	Median Home	Best For
Oahu	Urban, connected	\$1.05–1.1M	Careers, families, infrastructure
Maui	Lifestyle, beauty	\$1.1–1.3M	Remote workers, lifestyle seekers
Big Island	Space, affordable	\$450–600K	Affordability, land, rural life
Kauai	Remote, natural	\$950K–1.1M	Nature lovers, retirees

 **Key point:** Don't pick an island from a Google search. Visit first. Drive the commute. Shop the grocery store. Feel it.

# 3. The Cost of Getting There

## Moving Costs

Shipping container West Coast: **\$3,000–\$9,000**

Shipping a car: **\$1,200–\$2,000** from West Coast

Oahu first/last/deposit move-in: **\$8,500–\$10,500+**

Short-term housing while searching: **\$3,000–\$6,000/month**

Annual mainland flights for a family of 4: **\$1,200–\$2,800+**

## The Rule of Thumb

Have at least **6 months cash reserve** beyond your move costs.

Hawaii will test it.



## 4. Explore First. Always.

Explore somewhere before buying. **No exceptions.**

**You will learn your real commute**

**You will find your real neighborhood**

**You will understand what you actually need in a home**

**Then buy with confidence instead of regret**



## 5. The Culture — This Part Matters

Hawaii has a living indigenous culture. **Respect it. Learn it.**

**"Local" is earned through humility and time — not a ZIP code**

**Remove shoes at the door. Don't honk. Show up to the potluck.**

**The Aloha Spirit is literally state law (HRS §5-7.5) — it's not a tourism slogan**

**People who thrive here came to be part of Hawaii. Not to recreate the mainland with better weather.**

- **Never visited before signing a lease**

- **Burned mainland bridges before knowing if it truly fits**

- Genuine respect for the culture

## ✗ Hawaii Struggles If:

- You're chasing a vacation feeling
- Income is uncertain
- Your budget has no margin
